Integrative Approaches to Second Language Reading and Language Development

This workshop will introduce participants to recent developments in L2 reading pedagogy. Bottom-up and top-down approaches will be discussed and demonstrated within an integrative framework emphasizing both skill specific and whole language development in concert with one another. Strategies for reading materials development and adaptation as well as considerations for reading assessment will also serve as prominent themes in this workshop.

Lance Askildson is a Ph.D. Candidate in the Second Language Acquisition and Teaching program at the University of Arizona with research interests in L2 reading psycholinguistics and pedagogy.
