## Web 2.0 — Interactive Technologies in the World Language Classroom

This workshop will explore the learning possibilities in current Web 2.0 trends during the morning sessions. The afternoon development sessions provide the opportunity to explore and (co-)create lessons using the most intriguing tools. We will survey: blogs, virtual storytelling, social networking for teachers and for students, personalized web portals, social bookmarking, YouTube, TeacherTube and SchoolTube, podcasting (audio and video), and course (content) management software. At the end of this workshop, participants will have co-created and published one or more pedagogical use for each of the tools, as well as a whole or partial real-world lesson incorporating one of more of the elements learned each day. All sites and steps will be provided in reference materials which may be either printed or accessed online. This workshop provides an opportunity to create a learning community which can continue to collaborate and flourish after the workshop.
